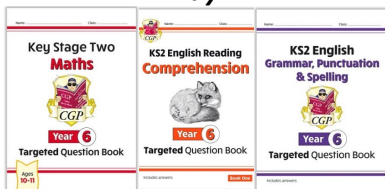
## Meet our new House Captains & Prefects!
