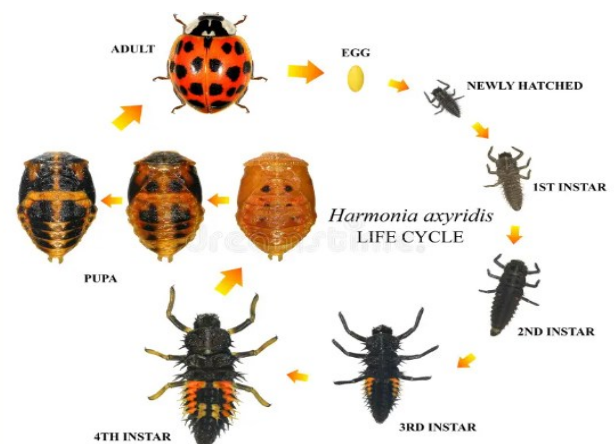
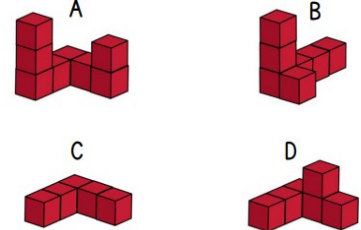
## English
