Yr 6 Residential - PGL Caythorpe Court - Medication Requirements

Dear Parents and Carers,

With the Yr 6 PGL Residential fast approaching, if your child has prescribed medication, it is now time to check quantities and if necessary order a repeat prescription to ensure your child has sufficient prescription medication to take on their trip.

If your child requires medication (whether prescribed or for travel sickness, hay fever etc.), please complete the attached 'Parental Agreement for Dereham C of E Junior Academy Staff to Administer Medication Form' and bring the completed form along with the medication to the school office by next **21st June 2024** at the very latest. All prescription medication should be clearly labelled by the pharmacy and we will require all non-prescribed medication to be clearly named too.

Please complete the form in full stating the correct dosage and times your child is required to take the medication. Without a completed medication form, DJA staff will not be able to administer any medication.

Please note: the school will provide paracetamol for the duration of the trip and will administer this as deemed necessary. Please Do Not bring in paracetamol from home, we will not have the storage capacity available for individuals to bring their own paracetamol. There will also be a spare inhaler available for emergencies.
