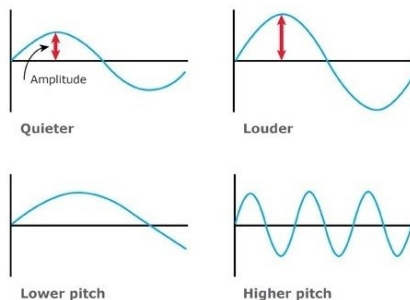
Writing
