Please find below some key information:

#### **Welcome Meetings**

As mentioned in a previous letter before the Summer Holidays, we will be holding welcome meetings next weeks. These meetings will give you more information about school life at DJA and in Year 3! There is no need to sign up, just turn up.

The dates and times are:

Monday 9<sup>th</sup> September 9:00am-9:30am Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2:30pm-3:00pm Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> September 6:00pm-6:30pm

We have varied the times and dates to make sure most parents can attend. Don't worry if you have younger children with you, all are welcome.

The meetings are all the same so you only need to attend one.

## **Reading and Homework Expectations**

In Year 3, children will be expected to do:

- A minimum of 3 x 15 min reading sessions
- A weekly times table task (paper)
- A weekly spelling task (paper)
- Additional homework online on TTRockstars and Spelling Shed is encouraged

Homework sheets will be given on a Friday and collected in a week later the following Friday.

We will be teaching the children how to login and use Times Table Rock Stars and Spelling Shed. Therefore, if they would like to do this extra practice, please wait until after half term.

Reading is a fundamental life skill and it's really important that children have plenty of practice both in and out of school. We will be finding the appropriate level of book for your child and giving them a reading book by the end of Wednesday 18th September. In the meantime, please read with your child at home if you are able to.

We expect parents to help us track the children's reading by signing their reading record. Reading records and completed homework sheets will be checked every Friday with house points and other rewards given.
