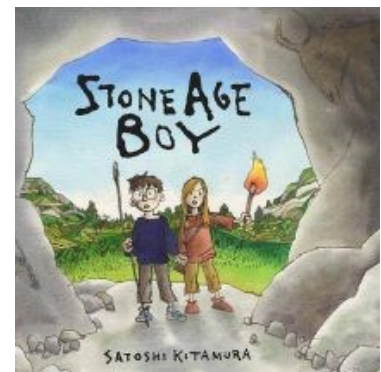
The Stone Age!
