Maths

In the last two weeks of maths, we've been learning about place value up to 10,000.

We have been learning how to write, partition, compare and put these numbers on a number line.

We have also been practicing our arithmetic skills.

English

We have looked at how to use fronted averbials, subordinate clauses and expanded noun phrases to make our writing more entertaining for the reader.

Other work
