

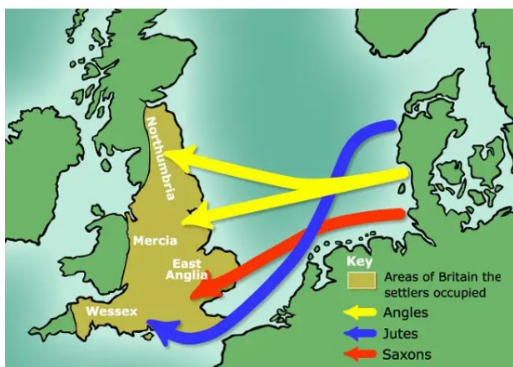


A big well done to all of year 5 this week for completing their Autumn assessments. You have all worked incredibly hard!

How did England become England?

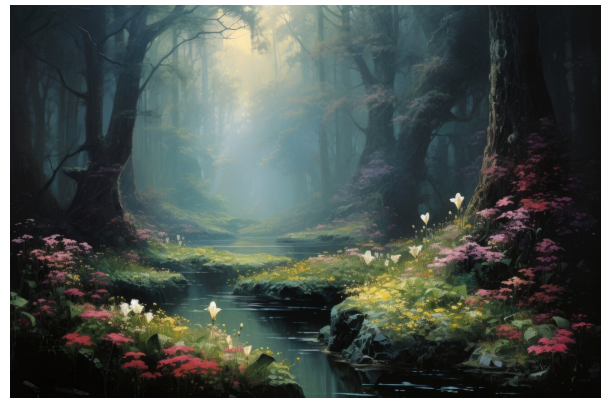

How could you describe this picture?



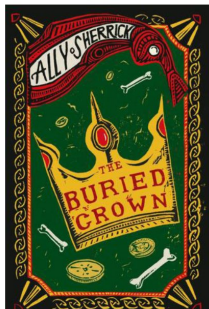
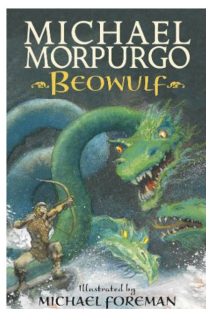
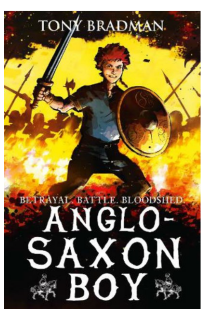
