

English—Narrative

Having written superb non-chronological reports about their chosen planets, the children have now begun to explore effective ways to write the opening of a space themed narrative.

Using description, dialogue or action to engage the reader, they will use features of show, not tell to help the reader infer what their characters are thinking or feeling.



Intergalactic Investigators

Over the last two weeks, the children have planned, carried out and recorded conclusions of two investigations. We explored how we could ensure a rover landed safely on Mars using air resistance to slow it down. Working in small groups, the children planned their own investigations which explored how streamlined objects can travel through water.
