

# The MEGALODON

The Megalodon, also known as the Carcharocles Megalodon- its latin name- luckily went extinct over 2 million years ago. This irascible marine creature has been estimated to have reached lengths of 40 to 60 feet by marine biologists. It has been reported that this species had a lifespan of approximately 20-40 years. Known as the ruler of the sea, this oceanic specimen was feared by many sea creatures.

### Amazing body



Due to the fact that Megalodons ate a lot of food per day, these creatures weighed as much as 30 Great White Sharks making it one of the most frightening-looking fish. Infant megalodon -which were only around six feet long-were very often eaten by other adult sharks. It is believed that scientists have found hundreds of Megalodon teeth(the size of bananas), in multiple seas and beaches in different countries.
